The Netherlands are honored to share its experiences and long tradition of research:

1973: warning labels and a categorization system (since 1991) for medicinal drugs

1974: introduction of legal blood alcohol limit for drivers of 0.5 g/l

1975: established institutes for drugs & driving research (Utrecht University, University of Groningen and Maastricht University)

1975: on-the-road driving tests for measuring effects of (medicinal) drugs on driving

2006: lowering the legal blood alcohol limit for novice drivers from 0.5 g/l to 0.2 g/l

2008: categorization system for computerized decision support systems in primary care

2017: introduction of legal limits for most frequently used illicit drugs
