Stipends for professionals from low and middle income countries (LMIC) to attend the T2022 International Conference in Rotterdam, The Netherlands, August 28-31, 2022.

A Stipend (€ 2,000.00, including registration fees) is intended to help researchers, students and workers in the field of traffic safety and forensic toxicology to attend T2022.

ICADTS uses the categories of the World Bank for defining Developing and Transitional Countries. For the current 2021 fiscal year, low-income economies are defined as those with a Gross National Income (GNI) per capita, calculated using the World Bank Atlas method, of \$1,035 or less in 2019; lower middle-income economies are those with a GNI per capita between \$1,036 and \$4,045; upper middle-income economies are those with a GNI per capita between \$4,046 and \$12,535; high-income economies are those with a GNI per capita of \$12,536 or more.

The ICADTS Foundation criterium for 2021 has been set based on a GNI less than US \$ 12,536.00 for deciding about the Developing and Transitional countries status for accepting the application.

Formal conditions:

- The application should be submitted by a person working in related fields of alcohol, drugs or traffic safety.
- Recipients of the Stipend will present (within 30 days after the Conference) a short report on their participation in T2022 for publication in the Newsletter of ICADTS, The Reporter.

Application:

Applicants should submit a request and disclose the following information:

- a) Name of the applicant
- b) Summary of applicant's background, including job description (not longer than one page A4)
- c) Details on the cost calculations
- Declaration by the applicant's supervisor that alternative funding to attend is not available for scientists from developing countries or by the student's or young scientist's mentor
- e) A description of how attending the event will help improve the career of the scientist
- f) Whether or not the applicant is a member of ICADTS
- g) Whether or not the applicant is submitting an abstract for the meeting
- h) Whether or not the applicant has attended an ICADTS meeting and whether support has been obtained previously
- Declaration by the applicant that he/she will accept the Stipend's formal conditions and will agree that the decision by the Executive Boards of ICADTS is not subject to appeal.

Deadline for submission:

Applications must be forwarded to the T2022 Organizers before 1st of March 2022.
